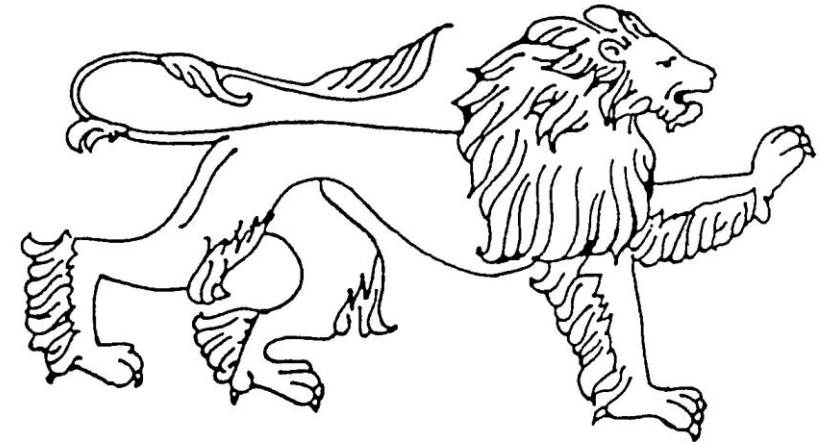

**THE LITURGY OF THE WORD**

Reading      Ecclesiasticus 38:27-32

So too is every artisan and master artisan who labors by night as well as by day;  
those who cut the signets of seals, each is diligent in making a great variety;  
they set their heart on painting a lifelike image,  
and they are careful to finish their work.

So too is the smith sitting by the anvil, intent upon his ironwork;  
the breath of the fire melts his flesh, and he struggles with the heat of the furnace;  
the sound of the hammer deafens his ears, and his eyes are on the pattern of the object.  
He sets his heart on finishing his handiwork, and he is careful to  
complete its decoration.

So too is the potter sitting at his work and turning the wheel with his feet;  
he is always deeply concerned over his products, and he produces them in quantity.

He moulds the clay with his arm and makes it pliable with his feet;  
he sets his heart to finish the glazing, and he takes care in firing the kiln.

All these rely upon their hands, and all are skillful in their own work. Without them no  
city can be inhabited, and wherever they live, they will not go hungry.
