## **General Information**

**Transportation:** Participants will meet in the lower parking lot at Saint Mark's on Saturday, May 29 very early in the morning (exact times will be given later). We'll travel to the boat terminal in San Pedro via bus, and will return to the parking lot in the late afternoon on Monday, May 31.

**The Camp:** Catalina Island Camps is located at Howlands Landing on the California side of Santa Catalina Island, 22 miles from the port of Los Angeles. A private pier extends into the cove providing the focal point for the water activities. Several hundred feet of beach on either side of the pier provide access to the ocean for swimming, skin diving, sailing and kayaking. Above the beach, several level acres dotted with trees provide the setting for living quarters and land activities.

**Food Service:** Food quality, quantity and service are an important part of camp. Breakfast is available at 8:00 AM, lunch is available between 12:00 Noon and 1:00 PM and dinner is at 6:30 PM. There is an entrée and meatless option at each meal, along with a fruit bar at breakfast and a salad bar at lunch and dinner.

**Camp Store:** The Camp Store stocks soda, candy, snacks, sunscreen, lip balm and other sundries, as well as souvenir T-Shirts. The store will be open each day during Community Camp.

**Child Care:** All children are welcome at Community Camp. We encourage children to participate in activities with their parents. However, during some activities, childcare will be available for toddlers to allow parents a chance to participate in the camp program. There is no additional charge for these services.
